

“8% × 3” SPECIAL OFFER – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

§ 1

1. These Terms and Conditions (“Terms and Conditions”) set forth the conditions and principles of the “8% × 3” Special Offer (hereinafter referred to as the “Special Offer”).
2. The Special Offer is organised by VEROLING Translation Agency (Biuro Tłumaczeń VEROLING sp. z o.o.), with its registered office in 30-552 Krakow, at ul. Wielicka 25/302, entered into the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register (KRS) kept by the District Court for the city of Krakow in Krakow, 11th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, under KRS number: 0000457810, REGON number: 122709959, NIP number: 6793086659, (hereinafter referred to as “VEROLING”).
3. The Special Offer is organised on the territory of the Republic of Poland in order to promote the translation or other services offered by the Organiser and to increase sales on the domestic market.

§ 2

1. The Special Offer consists of a discount offered according to the rules specified in these Terms and Conditions.
2. The Special Offer is addressed to people aged 18 or over.
3. The Special Offer is not available to employees and associates of the Organiser, companies assisting in the organisation of the Special Offer, as well as companies and natural persons who provide services to the Organiser on a permanent basis, including their employees, associates and family members.
4. The offer is valid from **March 7, 2017 (3:00 PM CET)** until **March 10, 2017 (6:59 PM CET)**.

§ 3

1. The discount applies to all the services specified on the Organiser’s website, as of **March 7, 2017**.
2. The Special Offer consists of the purchase of any 3 services by the customer (“Participant”) at the discounted price (–8%) during the period specified above.
3. This Special Offer cannot be used with other offers. The customer shall have the option to choose between the Organiser’s offers available at the time of this Special Offer.
4. The services purchased at the discounted price shall be subject to normal warranty terms.
5. The number of discounted packages is limited. The Organiser shall not be responsible for the non-availability of the packages.

§ 4

1. The personal data of the Participants shall be stored and processed by the Organiser and/or by entities acting on its behalf, to the extent necessary to run the Special Offer, communicate with the Participants, process orders and handle any possible complaints.
2. The processing of personal data shall include the following data: the first name, the last name, the phone number, the email address and company name, and shall cover the following scope of activities: collecting, processing and deleting the data.
3. The processing of personal data shall be carried out according to the regulations stipulated by the Personal Data Protection Act of 29th August 1997 (Journal of Laws from 2002, No. 101, item 926, as amended).
4. The personal data is provided by the Participants voluntarily, and the Participants shall be entitled to view and change the data.

§ 5

1. The Organiser shall provide the possibility to get acquainted with the Terms and Conditions for the duration of the Special Offer. The content of the Terms and Conditions shall be available to all interested parties at the office of Biuro Tłumaczeń VEROLING Sp. z o.o. as well as on the website: www.veroling.com.
2. Participation in the Special Offer is voluntary.
3. By participating in the Special Offer, the Participant declares that they have done so voluntarily, and that they have learned and fully accept the provisions of the Terms and Conditions.
4. The Organiser shall not be liable for the unavailability of the coupons (promotional codes) caused by reasons beyond the Organiser's control.
